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Preface

The world of literature for children is constantly evolving and expanding. *Children's Literature, Briefly* was written as an overview to shed light on children's literature and its use with young readers. The authors' intent was for the textbook reading experience to be educational and informative so that more and more people who are no longer children can learn or re-learn of the wonderful world of books for younger readers. The purpose of the test bank is similarly to help readers learn about the vast but fruitful fields of children's books. For each chapter of the textbook, a variety of multiple choice questions are presented. Additionally, students will have the opportunity to reveal their knowledge and learning through more expansive short answer and essay questions. Accordingly, the questions represent a range of levels of difficulty. In the answer key, page numbers are provided to direct the teacher to the specific page (or pages) where the answer is provided within the textbook. Furthermore, instructors should be aware that the lecture slides created to accompany each chapter have been designed to be complimented by the test bank. That is to say, the material upon which students will be tested in the test bank questions is largely covered in the material included in the lecture slides. Those students who have had the opportunity to attend a lecture in which the lecture slides have been used will have the advantage of exposure to specific material upon which they will then be tested.
