100. Describe what makes a cultural leader and the kinds of actions to be taken in order to move the business forward. ANSWER: A cultural leader defines and uses signals and symbols to influence corporate culture. The leader will clarify what a new culture should be by crafting a story that inspires people to change. There are two key areas that cultural leaders influence. The first area is articulating a vision for the organizational culture that the employees can believe in. The second is heeding the day-to-day activities that reinforce the cultural vision. For example, they would make sure to follow new work procedures and rewards systems to demonstrate how the culture works and that no one is exempt. One real-life situation involves the Whole Foods founder John Mackey, who wanted his managers to focus less on personal financial gain and more on making a better world. For this reason, he asked the board of directors to donate all his future stock options to the company's two foundations, the Animal Compassion Foundation and the Whole Planet Foundation.
