Below is the breakdown of the grading rubric for this Basic DDx case. You will be allowed to push the Hx Hints Button and receive feedback on your history questions 5 times per case.

Your history question limit for your patient is **90 questions**, please use them wisely.

- a) HPI statement (10% of grade)
- b) Plan covering all critical components of patient's final diagnosis (40%)
- c) Overall i-Human percentage (50%)

The software platform is designed to help you become proficient in the diagnostic reasoning process (the steps prior to the final diagnosis), so you can apply this process in the real clinic setting. Key to minimizing medical errors is the clinical consideration of a broad differential diagnosis list and the selection of tests to either "rule in" or "rule out" these diagnoses.

### Reason for Encounter

Start with open-ended patient-centric questions.

Graded	Approach	Question	Response	Information Obtained Clinic Notes
●	CC Sx	How can I help you today?	I have a bad headache.	
●	Assoc Sx	Have you been nervous, anxious or worried about something?	Yes... maybe... I don't know. (looks away).	
●	Assoc Sx	Are you having any trouble with your vision?	No. I know what you're talking about... my girlfriend gets that before her headaches come on.	
✗	Assoc Sx	Is it possible that you are pregnant?	Oh, I doubt it. Are you asking that because of my headache? No. I've had headaches like this before and I've never been pregnant.	
●	Assoc Sx	Have you been depressed?	Uh... no... I don't think so.	
✗	Assoc Sx	Have you been having fevers?	Not with this... and nothing recently.	
✗	Assoc Sx	Do you have any tingling and/or numbness anywhere?	Not with this headache. Maybe sometimes if I lay on my arm wrong, or something like that.	
●	Assoc Sx	Do you have any other symptoms or concerns we should discuss?	Really, just the headache.	
●	Assoc Sx	Do you have any sensitivity to light?	Now? No. Not sound, either.	
✗	Assoc Sx	Do you have nausea and/or vomiting?	No, just the headache.	
✗	Assoc Sx	Do you feel a lack of coordination?	Not now. I'm just kind of clumsy sometimes.	
			Right now? No, just my head.
