This drug not only reverses respiratory depression but also reverses the analgesia provided by opiates. - **Exact Answer:** Naloxone (Narcan) may need to titrate dose to prevent sudden withdrawal can be repeated in 2-3 min intervals has a shorter half life than opiods

Priority assessments needed when a patient double doses on opiates such as\_\_\_\_. - Exact Answer: Respiratory rate (RR) and Level of consciousness (LOC)

Side effects of opiods are - Exact Answer: constipation, pruitus, urinary retention, low BP, and low heart rate (HR)

Long term pain can be managed with a \_\_\_\_\_, it is considered a good opiate for patients with strong pain and have renal impairment. - Exact Answer: Fentanyl (Duragesic) patch only use in patients that are opiod tolerant

\_\_\_\_\_ is an opiod analgesic that may be used for treating the pain of pancreatitis; it is not used as much any longer due to seizure risk but has been used in pancreatitis pain. - Exact Answer: Meperidine (Demerol)

patient is no longer getting relief from the same dosage. Requires more med to get the same benefit as previously.

A nonopiod analgesic for peripheral neuropathy, postherapetic (shingles) neuralgia, and fibromyalgia. - Exact Answer: Pregabalin (Lyrica)
