Blurred vision.

64. A nurse is assessing a client who is 1 day postpartum & has a vaginal hematoma. Which of the following manifestations should the nurse expect?

Vaginal pressure.

65. A nurse is caring for a client who is at 36 weeks of gestation & has a positive contraction stress test. The nurse should plan to prepare the client for which of the following diagnostic tests?

Biophysical profile.
